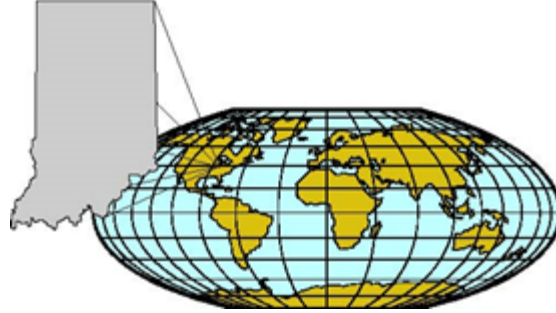

Purpose

The Central Indiana Technical and Environmental Societies (CITES) presents its Annual Symposium for the purpose of informing and assisting technical and managerial professionals in seeking solutions to environmental challenges. This Symposium is dedicated to the legalities and technicalities of complying with Indiana and federal environmental requirements.

Environmental concerns and regulations are constantly changing and expanding. The CITES Program Committee has selected the topics believed to be most timely. The goal is to provide a one-day conference which surveys important recent developments needed to stay current with environmental issues. The speakers are selected for their knowledge and experience in their respective subject areas.

Symposium Proceeds

Over \$150,000 has been awarded by CITES for this cause. CITES is a not-for-profit corporation (Tax ID Number: 31-1122167).
