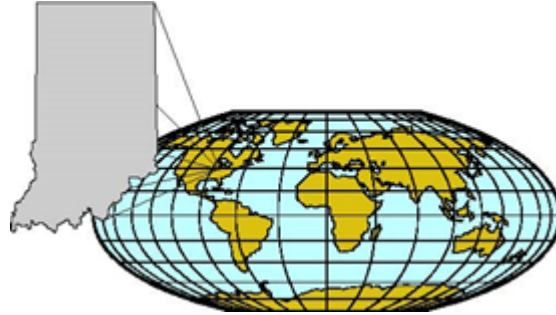

## Purpose

The Central Indiana Technical and Environmental Societies (CITES) presents its Annual Symposium for the purpose of informing and assisting technical and managerial professionals in seeking solutions to environmental challenges. ## Symposium Proceeds
